

4.3 Develop and evaluate rapid multiplication models and strategies for the effective and efficient production of clean seeds and rapid dissemination of new varieties through the seed system

Investigate alternative models for publicprivate funding of core activities at a local, national and regional scale to ensure sustainability of interventions.

Optimize agronomic practices (variety, density, fertilizer) for the economic production of both cassava roots and clean planting material in different agro-ecological and value chain contexts for the development of sustainable farmer seed producers.

Develop innovative business models to strengthen the value chain for the production and movement of 'clean' (and later resistant) planting material from suppliers to purchasers






Locations of case studies



- 3. HLARC, Vietnam






Status of CMD in Mainland SE Asia
